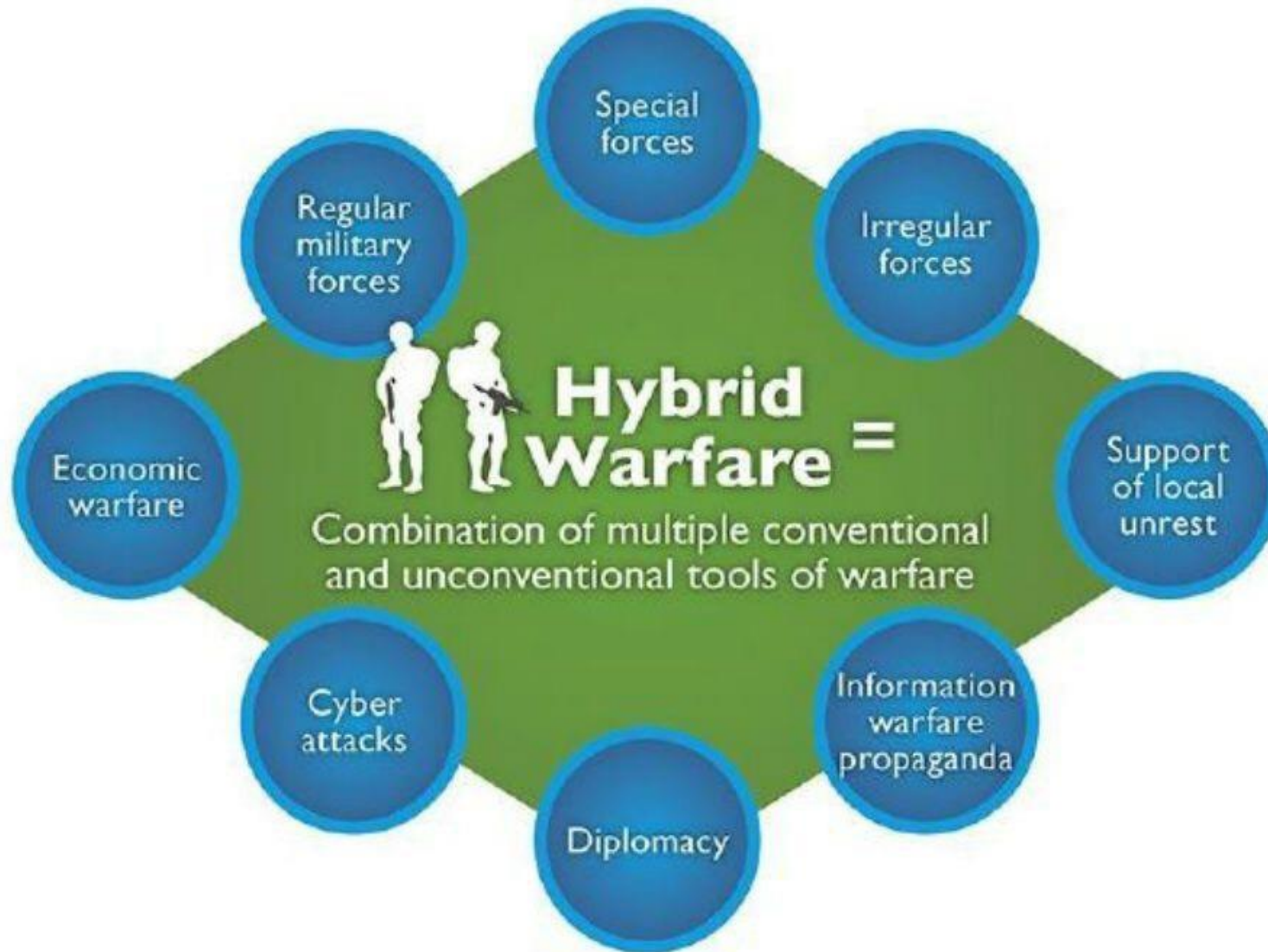

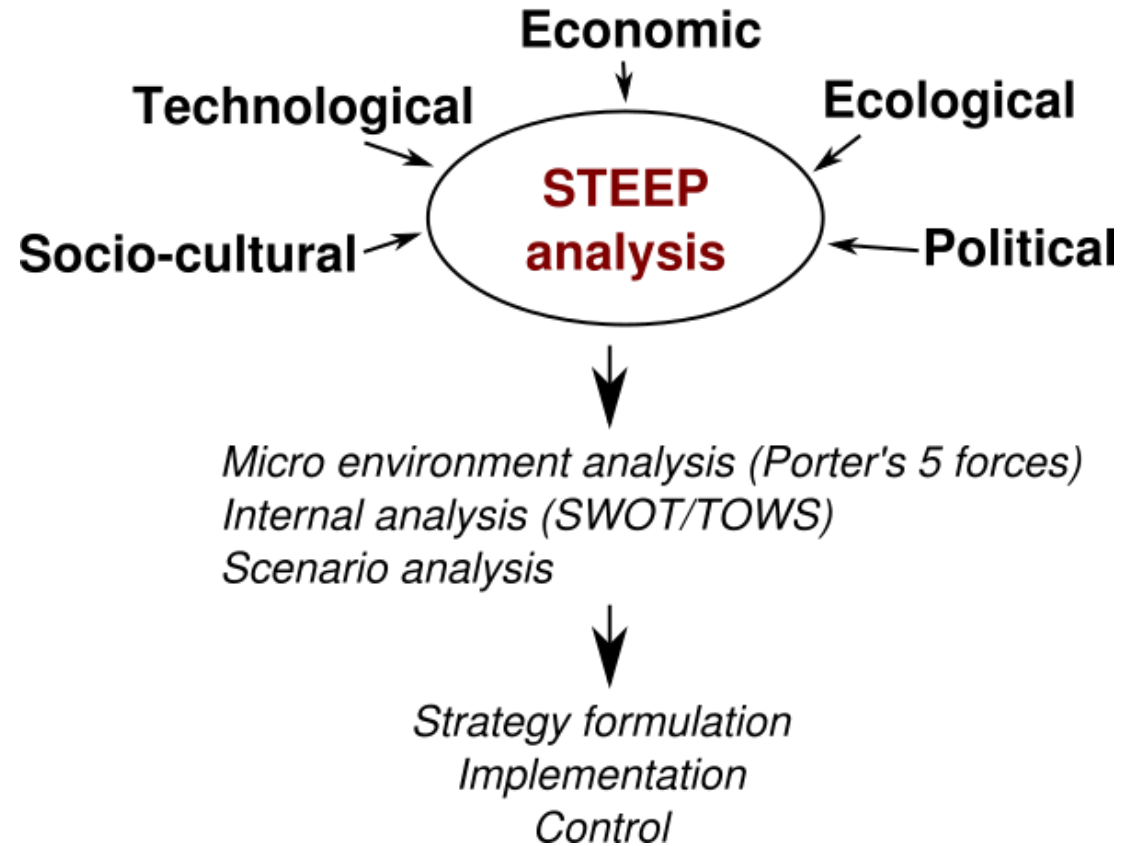

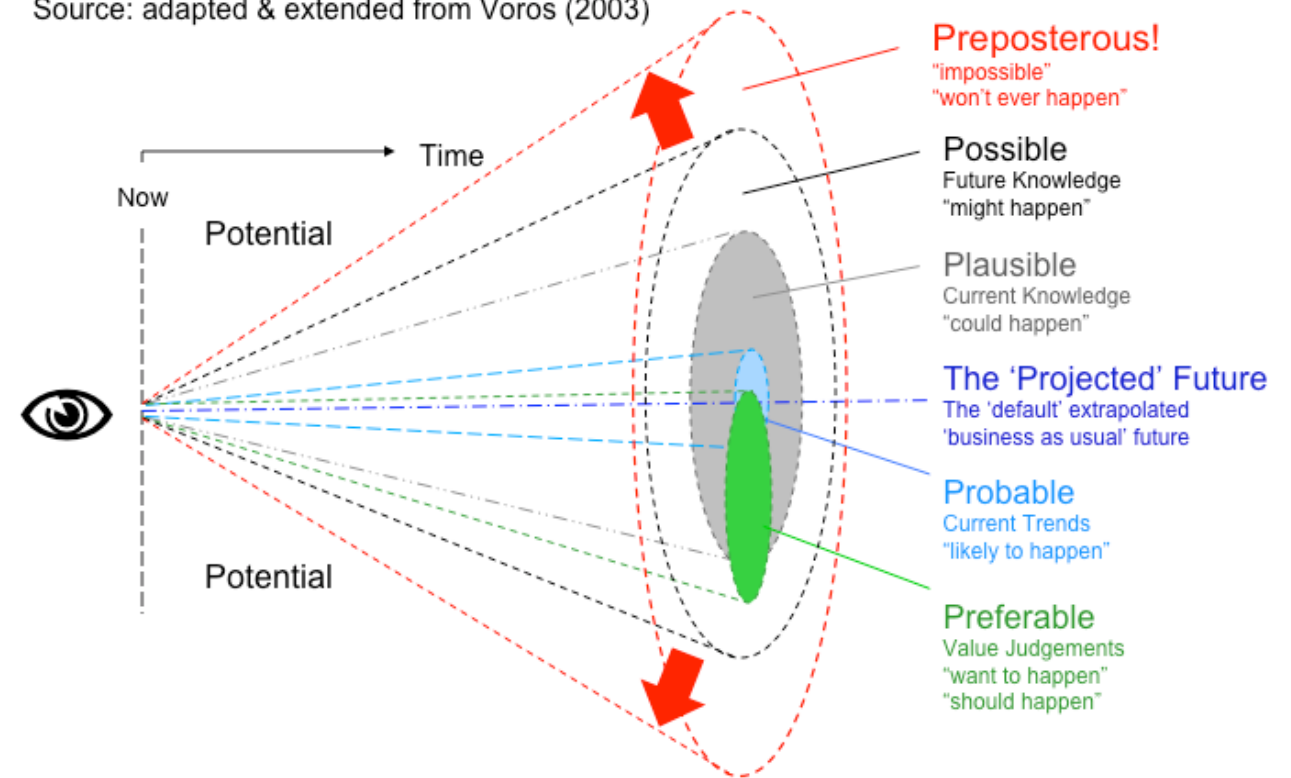

7 types of alternative futures

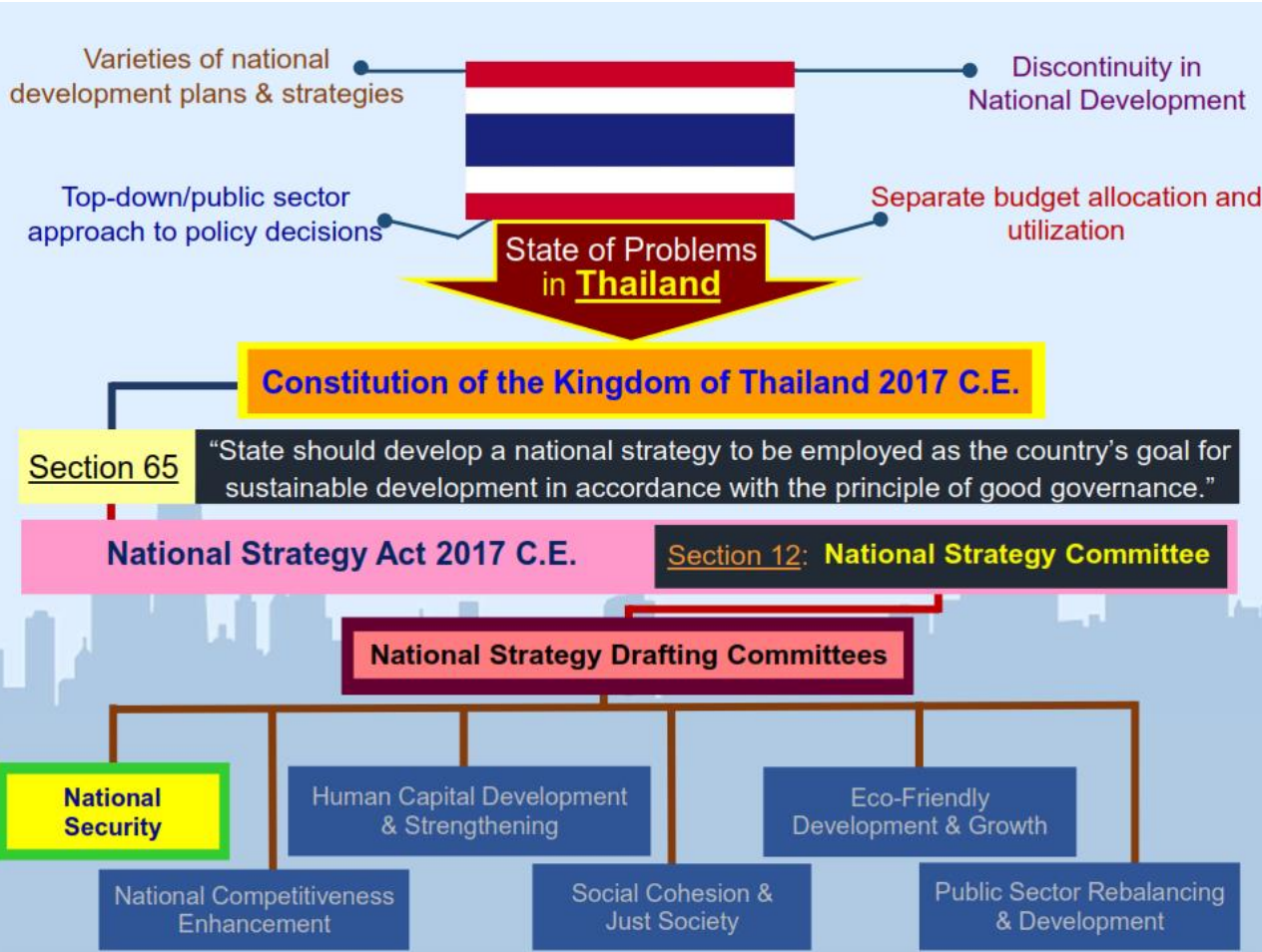

To promote environmentally and friendly growth with improved quality of life.

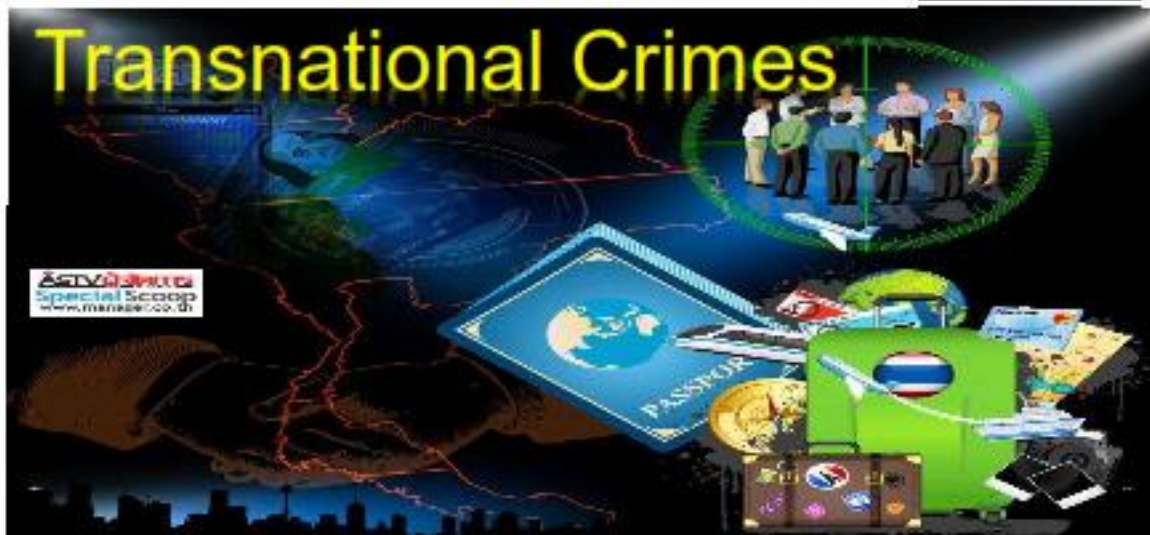
6. Public Sector Rebalancing & Development

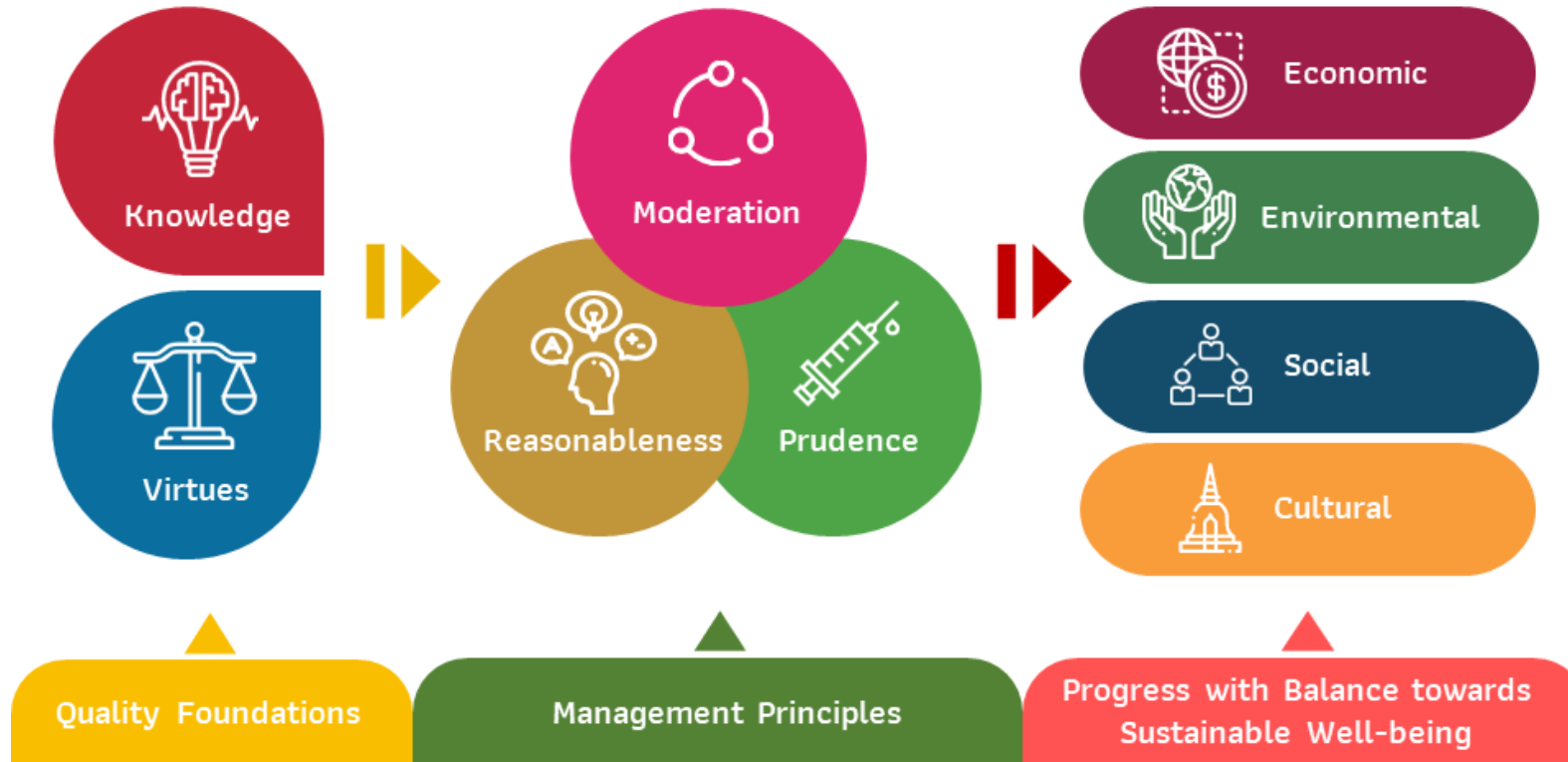
