Professional experience: Corporate world during the 2000s includes BMW (for seven years), Siam Commercial Bank as head of Corporate communications.



Wit is currently hosts The Standard Podcast '8 Minute History' streamed every Tuesday and Thursday.








The World Economy

Total Allocated Exchange Reserves by Currency (in \$)












Euro-Dollar exchange rate

From January 1, 2003 to July 12, 2022






