- Match action with words










2. Peace negotiations and meaningful autonomy

- Empower local government

- Improve local governance

- Support infrastructure and systems
- Develop intra-regional trade









5. More institutionalized maritime border cooperation

- Coordinate efforts
- Synchronize operations
- Enhance intelligence-sharing
