
SUSTAINABLE SECURITY










GOVERNMENT PRESENCE IN PREVIOUSLY UNGOVERNED SPACES

Conclusions and Recommendations

- ASEAN/ADMM cooperation on local governance. Cooperation and sharing of best practices among local government units and law enforcement agencies on peace and order, intelligencegathering, trade promotion, and delivery of basic services. (Involve small- and medium-scale businesses, trading communities, and non-government organizations.)
- ASEAN/ADMM maritime border cooperation, especially on customs and immigration, proliferation of small arms and light weapons and other illegal goods.
- ASEAN/ADMM creative and region-wide initiatives to counter violent extremism at the regional level, targeting the youth.
